

## Step 2: You can access the course by clicking on the "Start the Mandatory Course" button, as highlighted in the image..


How to Apply:

- 5. Submit Credentials:After completing the course, submit proof of successful completion to pd@albertarealtor.ca or email pd@albertarealtor.ca with conference registration information, if you use the conference substitution. We will update your member account and provide credit for your 2024 Mandatory Course.
